Scanning

Main Texts: Hebrews 1:1-3; 2:14-18; 4:14-16

Introductory Question: Do you tend to think more of Jesus as God or as man? Why?

Going Deeper

1. If you were to need to prove biblically that Jesus is God, how would you do it?
2. What is the big idea of Hebrews 1:1-3?
3. How do we know that Jesus was (and is) a real man?
4. What do each of the following passages tell us about Jesus own self-identity?
 - Matthew 9:2-3
 - Matthew 11:27-28
 - John 5:21-23
 - John 1:1-2 and 20:28
5. Philippians 2:5-11 is an early church “song” that celebrates both the deity of Jesus and the humanity of Jesus. Read it together and look for the evidences of both.
6. Read 1 John 1:1-4 and 4:1-3. What does the Apostle John seem to be very concerned that we realise?

Applying

7. What practical difference does it make to you that Jesus is not only human, but God?
8. What practical difference does it make to you that Jesus is not only God, but man?
9. Elizabeth Elliot wrote the following about her experience as missionary (via a fictional novel, No Graven Image). How does this quote make you feel? Have you had any experiences in your life that this would relate to?

“Now in the clear light of day, I see that Jesus, if he was merely my accomplice, had betrayed me. If, on the other hand, he was God, he had freed me. For God is God, and if he is God, He is worthy of my worship and my service, and I will find rest nowhere but in His will, and that will is infinitely, immeasurably, unspeakably, beyond my largest notion of what He is up to.”
