Key Text: Luke 22:14-30

Open Discussion: Think about your own journey around vaccinations. How would you like those who think differently from you to think and treat you?

1. What significance do you see in the way Luke has recorded the Last supper and a dispute about greatness, butted next to each other?
2. How does entering the story of Jesus through communion change the way we view life?
3. When we find ourselves disagreeing with others, how much should we express our views and how much should we hear well? Compare with James 1:19
4. When we find emotions bubbling up within us, what are we learning about ourselves in that moment?
5. Which image did you find resonated with you and which did you find difficult?
 - a. Table: The welcome of others
 - b. Bread: Our unity with others
 - c. Cup: Giving up our rights for othersDiscuss the 'why' of this for you.
6. When we find ourselves disagreeing with one another, how does Eph 4:2-3 and Phil 1:27 speak into these moments?
