

Life Group Leaders' Questions – Romans 5-8

Be Who You Are. Sunday September 20, 2020 (online church)

Discussion Starter: God is at work, changing your character. Describe your level of awareness of how God is changing you, and what it is like in your experience.

Digging Deeper into the Word

1. "Be who you are". According to Romans 5-8, who are you? Pick out the most compelling truth and share how it impacts you.
2. What other examples are there in Scripture where God says: "This is who you are, now live like it"?
3. The good news of grace, God's unmerited favour, makes us right with God by faith. How does the gospel become a power for us to change in our present circumstances? Think about the arguments of Romans.

4. We often refer to our present transformation and growth as "sanctification" – the process of our characters becoming more like Jesus. What does this have to do with the mission of bringing hope to the world?
5. Share one area, right now, where you know God wants you to change. Describe what is hard about it, how you might have tried and failed in the past, and what hope today's truths gives you.
6. What is your one big take-away, for your life, from this discussion. Pray for each other.
