Small Group Discussion Questions

Discussion Starter: Ask group members to rate their outreach temperature on a scale of 0 - 10 (10 means you are on fire, active in sharing your faith; 0 means it is the last thing on your heart and mind). Give examples for your rating.

Digging Deeper

1. We have just finished Romans 1-4 in our series, which unpacks the big truths of the gospel (God-Sin-Christ-Faith). How does the good news have an innate "sending" in it? In other words, how does the gospel make us go? See Romans 1:15-17.

Changing Our Hearts

2. In the Panel Discussion, Norm and Lois were asked the following questions. What was most helpful in how they answered? How would you have answered the questions?

"I can see gospel opportunities around me, but where do I even get started in sharing the good news?"

"It's one thing to talk about generic spiritual things like "faith" and "church", but how do I actually talk about the gospel message itself?"

3. On Sunday May 31 we are starting a series called RESET. Covid-19 has disrupted us and God is resetting us. What would be the number 1 change be that you would like to make in the way you share your faith? What needs to happen to make that a new normal?

Family and Children Discussion Questions

- 1. Steve shared about how at first glance a car is a normal and everyday part of life. But....under the hood....a whole lot more is going on that we don't see. How is that like our normal and everyday lives....with God?
- 2. Share who the people are that you spend time with in your ordinary, everyday life. How would it change things for you if you believed that God was sending you to them to share His love?
- 3. Take some time to pray as a family, by name, for the people you have been talking about. What should you pray?
