2. Read these four passages and observe what is similar and what is different in each one.

 - b. John 4:28-29
 - c. Matthew 4:18-19
 - d. Matthew 28:19-20

3. “The Christian life is not about getting God to fit into our story, but about finding our place in his great story.” What does this statement mean? Why is it incredibly crucial for our time of RESET? What does it have to do with living on mission?
4. Do you “have to” witness about Jesus to be a Christian?

Living it Out

5. Imagine you have 60 seconds to talk to someone who does not share your faith (e.g, you are walking to the next work meeting; you are in an elevator about to get out; your child is about to come to you at the school gate as you chat to another parent).
 - a. How would you share the gospel?
 - b. How would you share your story of coming to faith in Jesus?
6. “Find the evangelism style that most excites you and go for it.” Discuss this application and whether or not you find it helpful.
7. We were encouraged to pray daily for our “neighborhood” – specifically, the person/people to whom we believe that God has sent us. Who are your people?
